WE WANT YOUR COMPUTERS

With the ongoing WEEE Directives and the hazardous waste directives that came in July 2005, it's not easy being green.

So for all our donators, we'll try and simplify it for you. IT equipment is hazardous waste. CRT monitors contain 4lb of lead in the screen to protect you from radiation and the base units contain all manner of nasties.

You must register your premises as a hazardous waste producer before we can collect or accept delivery of your equipment. Do it online for just £18 at www.environment-agency.gov.uk/subjects/waste/1019330/1217981/1218079

There are exemptions for various offices, shops, etc. but these only apply to producers of under 200kg per year (equivalent to 6 computers per year). The agency will give you a Premises Code. Pass this to us and we will then make the collection. We will even supply the Hazardous Waste Consignment Note for you.

We will collect redundant IT equipment anywhere in West Yorkshire at the following rates:

PC-Monitors £3
Non-PC-Monitors £8
Printers/Servers/Misc Box £2,
Base Unit £1

Plus 50p per mile round trip to Castleford. Plus £10 for each Consignment Note Return (we pay that to the Environment Agency) Plus of course, the dreaded VAT.

We take ownership of the equipment absolving you from any further responsibility for it and provide a Consignment Note Return after each collection along with a computer generated audit trail of all donated items which proves your compliance with Hazardous Waste and Duty of Care regulations.

We use specialist sanitising software to clean and overwrite all hard disks so no data can be retrieved.

NEWS SNIPPETS

Waste & Resources Action Programme (WRAP) research suggests that the UK recycling sector is achieving emission cuts equivalent to taking 3.5 million cars off the roads.

The Prime Minister's "green guru", Sir Jonathon Porritt, has championed the contribution of recycling to UK action on climate change.

Sir Jonathon, who was appointed by Tony Blair to lead the independent Sustainable Development Commission six years ago, said: "Some people still don't get the connection between climate change and recycling."

The results are clear and positive for recycling; it delivers between 10 to 15 million tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent emission cuts compared to the current mix of landfill and energy-from-waste."

In 06/2004 Samsung was the first major electronics company to commit to phasing out all BFRs and PVC. In 06/2006 Many others, including Dell commits to plans to phase out a list of hazardous chemicals with priority on BFR and PVC by 2009. Currently, Apple have made no such commitment and are now the subject of a campaign by Greenpeace.

Acer topples Dell to take No.2 spot. Following strong Q3 results, Acer has usurped Dell to reach the second place in the EMEA PC market. According to data released by Gartner, Acer's sales grew by 37 per cent in Q3 – three times that of the global PC market as a whole. In the notebook segment, the firm recorded 40.2 per cent growth giving it a 20.9 per cent market share

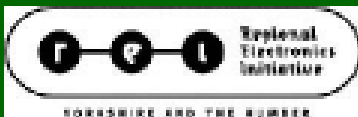
